At its November 20-24, 2020 meeting, the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) Committee on Recognition reviewed and accepted the Follow-up Report submitted by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (COAMFTE-AAMFT).

COAMFTE-AAMFT was recognized by CHEA in April 2014 for a period of 10 years. If COAMFTE-AAMFT is planning to seek subsequent recognition from CHEA, the *Guidelines* that accompany the 2019 recognition policy call for completion of the recognition process by the end of the final year of the current period of recognition (December 2024).
